

## Storage of Pesticides – Chap 22 Regulatory Requirements

- **During storage of pesticides, applicators must not leave pesticides or containers in any area which is readily accessible to unauthorized persons, wildlife, or livestock.**
- Legible labels must be maintained on stored pesticides at all times.
- **Read the Label!** Storage requirements for each product will be listed on the label and must be followed.

## Pesticide Storage Areas General Guidance

- **Storage areas should be:**
  - **LOCKED!!;**
  - Posted with weatherproof signs that say “**Danger – Pesticides – Unauthorized Persons Keep Out!**”;
  - Fenced, with locked gate (if a separate building);
  - Well ventilated and dry;
  - Well lit; and,
  - Temperature controlled.



## Storage of Pesticides General Guidance

- Store herbicides apart from other pesticides, fertilizers and seeds – cross contamination.
- Flammable pesticides should be stored separately from non-flammables – preferably in a fire-proof cabinet.
- Store liquid formulations below dry formulations.
- Never store with food, feed, seed or veterinary supplies.
- Keep spill kit and decontamination kits in area.
- Keep list of pesticides in 2 locations.
